



USE CHALK TO DRAW PICTURES AND DESTINATIONS AND EXPAND BY:

EXPRESSIVE LANGUAGE:

- ASKING THE KIDS WHERE THEY WANT TO GO
- ASK THE KIDS TO SEQUENCE WHERE THEY WANT TO GO FIRST, SECOND, LAST ETC.
- ASK THE KIDS HOW THEY WILL GET TO DIFFERENT PLACES. (IE. HOP TO THE SCHOOL, RIDE TO THE PARK, OR RUN TO THE GARDEN

RECEPTIVE LANGUAGE:

- TELL THE KIDS TO GO TO THE PARK
- TELL THE KIDS TO GO TO THE PARK AND THEN TO THE GARDEN
- ASK THE KIDS, "WHERE CAN WE BUY APPLES?"
- CHALLENGE RECEPTIVE LANGUAGE WHEN YOU CAN BY ASKING THE KIDS TO RIDE TO HEB AND GET 2 APPLES.

PRETEND PLAY:

- ASK THE KIDS TO FIND A LOCATION AND PRETEND TO BE AT THE LOCATION. CAN YOU HELP ME DIG THE DIRT AND PLANT SOME FLOWERS?
- ASK THE KIDS TO GO TO THE POOL, WHAT DO WE NEED TO BRING? PRETEND TO PUT ON BATHING SUITS, SUNSCREEN AND PACK A BAG FOR THE POOL. DO WE NEED TO EAT ANYTHING AT THE POOL?
- GO TO THE GROCERY STORE AND "SHOP!"

 TO TRAVEL TO THE LOCATION CHOSEN.
